COUNCILMAN SIMMONS ARRIVES

Council heard from Dr. Bill Brozovich along with Atty. Phil Mansour, President of the Delta Sportsplex Foundation, Atty. Britt Virden, Vice President, and citizen Coach Elijah Moore concerning a proposed Sportsplex. The Sportsplex will be located on a 93-100 acre lot behind the Convention Center. Washington County owns the land and has agreed to a lease.

The complex will encompass league teams for 7-14 year olds as well as health and fitness classes along with other athletics. It is expected to generate millions of dollars in revenue for the City of Greenville.

Dr. Brozovich, Atty. Mansour and Atty. Virden are requesting Council's support in the form of a resolution supporting a 2% tax on all hotels located within the county.

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE REQUEST OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI FOR THE ENACTMENT OF LOCAL AND PRIVATE LEGISLATION PERMITTING AND AUTHORIZING WASHINGON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI TO EMPOSE A TWO PERCENT (2%) DAILY ROOM TAX ON ALL HOTELS AND MOTELS LOCATED AND DOING BUSINESS IN WASHINGTON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI TO SUPPORT AND HELP FUND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SPORTS COMPLEX FOR THE YOUTH OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Washington County, Mississippi and the Washington County Mississippi Convention & Visitors Bureau have supported the creation, development and establishment of a sports complex in Washington County, Mississippi, to provide athletic facilities for baseball, soccer and other sports activities for the benefit of the youth of Washington County, Mississippi; and

WHEREAS, these entities have each passed Resolutions requesting local and private legislation authorizing the imposition by the County of a two percent (2%) daily room tax on all hotels and motels located and doing business in Washington County, and have requested that the City of Greenville support this requested legislation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Greenville, Mississippi believes that the creation and establishment of such a sports complex will enhance the quality of life and improve the health of the youth of Greenville, Mississippi and will also significantly attract tourism to the City of Greenville by providing facilities for local, regional and state athletic tournaments and events; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Greenville, Mississippi supports the creation, development and establishment of the sports complex in question;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Greenville, Mississippi, acting by and through its City Council, hereby requests that the Mississippi State Legislature pass and approve a local and private Bill permitting and authorizing Washington County, Mississippi to impose a two percent (2%) daily room tax on all hotels and motels located and doing business in Washington County, Mississippi to support and help fund the establishment of the sports complex for the youth of Washington County, Mississippi.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded forthwith to the Mississippi State Legislature for review, consideration and approval.
